About the Poll

These results are based on a survey of 405 likely voters in the November 2017 election in the City of Boston. Live telephone interviews were conducted September 27-October 1, 2017 via both landline and cell phone using conventional registration based sampling procedures. The margin of sampling error is 4.9 percentage points with a 95 percent level of confidence. The poll was sponsored by WBUR, a National Public Radio station in the Boston area.
