



WBUR Poll Survey of 504 Registered Voters in Massachusetts Field Dates: January 5-7, 2018

Overall, do you think things in Massachusetts are headed in the right direction, or are they off on the wrong track?



About the Poll

These results are based on a survey of 504 Massachusetts registered voters. Live telephone interviews were conducted January 5-7, 2018 via both landline and cell phone using conventional registration based sampling procedures. The margin of sampling error is 4.4 percentage points with a 95 percent level of confidence. The poll was sponsored by WBUR, a National Public Radio station in the Boston area.
