

Dear BPS Rising 9th and 10th Grade Families,

We are writing to inform you that BPS has discovered an error in how we calculated grade point averages (GPAs) to determine 7th-grade exam school eligibility. Although we work with an external auditor to ensure the accuracy of our data, neither the external auditor nor BPS' Office of Data and Accountability (ODA) caught the error before notices were sent out.

Since catching the error, the ODA and independent external auditor have revalidated the GPAs. We are confident in the accuracy of the new GPA calculations for rising 9th and 10th graders, but out of an abundance of caution, we are double-checking all grading data to ensure accuracy.

We will continue to keep you updated on our progress and **expect to have eligibility notices go out by the end of this week.** Exam school invitations are still scheduled for early May.
