New England Energy Imports from Canada

- \$10.2 billion worth of motor fuels, natural gas, and electricity annually
- 80 percent of New England's gasoline and diesel come from Canada (chiefly Irving refinery in Saint John, New Brunswick)
- 90 percent of Logan International Airport's jet fuel comes from Canada
- 13% of New England net electricity imported from Quebec, New York, and New Brunswick in 2023 (ISO-New England) ... more coming from Quebec via NECEC soon

Illegal Immigration and Fentanyl

- 1.5% of border apprehensions by US CBP were at Canadian border in FY 2024
- Fentanyl seizures at the border in FY 2024:
 - Mexico: 21,148 pounds
 - Canada: 43 pounds ... 0.2% of the total
