BROWN, TYLER E

1. On May 11, 2026, around 12:10pm, a Massachusetts parole officer called the Boston Police Department to report concerns with one of his parolees, identified as Tyler Brown. The parole officer stated that Brown, a known crack cocaine user, had told him over a phone call through Brown's regular phone number that he had relapsed and was ready to end his life. He had a drug screen test scheduled that day. The parole officer further stated that Brown is known to carry knives, had previously been involved in an officer-involved shooting, has a history with firearms, and owns an assault rifle.
2. Earlier that day, the parole officer had a meeting with another individual who lives in the same rooming house as Brown. The individual told the parole officer to meet with Brown because "he's off his rocker" and had been getting high all night before. The parole officer texted Brown, he wants to meet as soon as possible.
3. The parole officer called Brown at 12:00pm on May 11, 2026, but he did not answer. He finally got ahold of him at 12:08pm and could tell something was not right. Brown was expressing suicidal ideations, so the parole officer called 911 and his supervisor. The parole officer started driving to Brown's residence. Brown had just been released from an admission to McLean psychiatric hospital on May 8, 2026. He has previously been diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder, anxiety, and depression.
4. When the parole officer arrived at Brown's residence in Boston, Brown was not present. The parole officer received a Facetime video call from Brown who was calling from a different phone number than he had for their earlier phone call and spoke with him for several minutes. During the video call, the parole officer saw Brown waving around a semi-automatic rifle while inside a kitchen that was not the kitchen in Brown's residence. The parole officer believed that Brown was under the influence of drugs during the call. Brown made various statements on the call, including that "these people are gonna fucking pay," and "I'm not going back to prison." Brown also discussed murders he claimed he committed in the past, some that he did not get caught for. The parole officer took a screenshot of Brown to send to the police, at which point Brown ended the call.
5. The parole officer alerted the Boston Police Department of what he saw and heard during the Facetime call. The Boston Police obtained a search warrant to ping Brown's regular phone number through the U.S. Secret Service, which provided a 1000 meter radius in Cambridge, MA. The Parole Department obtained another warrant to get a more precise ping radius, which indicated his phone was within 100 meters of the area of 51 Kelly Rd. and 76 Pleasant St. in Cambridge, MA at 1:21pm. Cambridge PD and MSP were notified. Trooper Landon Veney and Cambridge PD put out a BOLO for Brown and various officers headed to the area of Kelly Rd.
6. At some point, Brown called the parole officer again. Brown described himself as no longer being Tyler Brown, and said he was now repping his "shooter name." They talked for another minute or so as he continued waving a firearm around, saying he's not going back to jail and making more suicidal statements.
7. Sometime after the call, Brown began walking down Memorial Drive in Cambridge, firing his rifle repeatedly in an erratic fashion. Two men, _____ and _____ who were sitting in their cars near the shooting were struck by gunfire. While sitting in her vehicle nearby, a female _____ describes a round passing nearby her jacket when it penetrated through the rear of her vehicle and exited through the front windshield. When Trooper Veney arrived on scene, Brown fired his gun at him. Trooper Veney and a civilian witness began firing back at Brown who was struck approximately in his extremities. Multiple videos were obtained which document the shooter's progression down Memorial Drive while he brandished and fired his weapon.
8. Investigators later interviewed the civilian witness who fired back at Brown. He said he was driving southbound on Memorial Drive when he saw a bunch of cars in front of him turning around and heard several gunshots. That witness is an experienced firearm owner with a license to carry, as he is an ex-Marine and used to be a firearm instructor. The witness then saw a black male with a long rifle, which he believed looked like an AK 47, on foot in front of his vehicle. The witness had a pistol in a safe in the backseat of his vehicle, so he retrieved the pistol (.9mm Glock 43) from the safe while covering himself. The witness saw the shooter get closer to him and go from the left side of his vehicle to the right side. The witness fired all 8 rounds from his firearm and then moved to a tree for cover, telling other people to get back. The witness heard sirens, so he locked his slide and put his firearm on the ground away from him. The witness heard 2 different calibers going off, which he believed to be originating from a trooper and the suspect. He heard the shooter yelling something but he did not remember what it was. The shooter eventually fell on the ground. Troopers rendered immediate aid and

transported Brown to Beth Israel Hospital. The witness was not injured, but his vehicle had two bullet holes in the driver's side door from the shooting.

9. MSP Ballistics recovered the firearm used in the shooting between the road and the bike path at the scene, which was identified as a multi-cal (.223/5.56) BCI Defense Model FF-15 (SERIAL NUMBER: FF00031). There was also a scope on the rifle. Over 60 spent rounds were located in the area. Brown does not have a license to carry firearms.
10. A review of Brown's criminal history through MassCourts and CJIS shows that he is currently on dual supervision parole and probation for various offenses, including armed assault to murder, attempted assault and battery with a firearm, three counts of assault with a dangerous weapon, carrying a firearm without a license (2nd offense), carrying a loaded firearm without a license, and possession of a large capacity firearm, as well as assault and battery with a dangerous weapon and witness intimidation. Brown's parole start date was May 21, 2025, and was set to terminate the end of the week; however, his probation would still have been ongoing.
11. Based on the above probable cause, I respectfully request Brown be charged with the following

 8. MGL 269 12E Discharge of a Firearm w/in 500 Feet of Dwelling
